

Sermon Discussion Questions
The Church Jesus is Building: Week 3
Acts 2:42-47

*Here are some questions to discuss as you think about the message from **Acts 2:42-47**.*

1. What stands out to you about the picture of Spirit-led community in the passage?
2. What is the early church *devoted* to? How does the Holy Spirit change the way we see the apostles' teaching, fellowship, and prayer?
3. Which of the two pictures best describes your life? Who is at the center of your picture? Why?
4. What does it mean to repent? What is your next right step of repentance?
5. Look closely at your personal devotion to learning Biblical doctrine, investing in community, and prayer. Where do you believe the Holy Spirit is working to rid you of pride and lead you to more dependence?

If you would like to dig a little deeper, here are some more scriptures to read and questions to guide you.

Read Galatians 5 in light of the picture of community in Acts 2:42-27 and respond to each of the following questions:

- What is the *essential teaching* of the gospel?
- What does it mean to "walk by the Spirit"? What is the alternative?
- What is the "fruit of the Spirit"? What is the alternative?
- What does it mean to "crucify the flesh with its passions and desires"?
- Where are you hesitant or afraid to let the Holy Spirit work in your life? Why?
- What do you need from someone in your group or from someone in the church right now?
- What do you feel led to give to someone from the church right now?
