Romans 15

1. In what ways are you already serving others rather than pleasing yourself? In what ways do you need to begin, motivated by Christ's example?
2. How do the truths about Scripture in 15:4 excite you about reading the Bible? How do they shape the way you approach the Bible?
3. How committed are you to praying for and pursuing unity among your church membership?
4. How has Paul's example encouraged and challenged you in your own gospel witness?
5. How has his example encouraged and challenged you in your own gospel giving?
6. Whose struggle could you enter into by praying for them now, and then continuing to do so daily?
7. Where do you see discouragement, arrogance, or complacency in your life as a follower of Jesus? How do you need the truths of this passage to comfort or challenge you today? How does this truth lead you to humble yourself and exalt God? Consider each of the following challenges from the message.
 - **One Mind**—What are you allowing to influence your thinking?
 - **One Voice**—What is the true object of your “attachment love” and worship?
 - **One Struggle**—What is your primary mission? Who is on that mission with you? How are you treating them?
 - **One Hope**—What is your source of strength for the future?
