

**Journey from the Cross**  
**He Has Risen, Indeed!**  
**Luke 24:13-27**

1. What do you believe about the resurrection of Jesus? Do you believe it's really true? Why?
2. What did Jesus reveal to Cleopas and the other disciple about the Bible? What question would you have asked Jesus?
3. What is their response to Jesus' teaching? Is that an experience you can relate to, or is it something completely foreign to you?
4. In his book *With: Reimagining the Way You Relate to God*, Skye Jethani contends, "Those with an incomplete or tainted vision of God either want to use him or dismiss him. But when a clear, full, and rapturous view of God is presented, we will not settle for anything less than being with him. The complete vision of God and his character comes not from within us, but is gifted to us in Jesus who "is the image of the invisible God." If the resurrection of Jesus is true, how might your vision of life *with God* look different than it does for you today?
5. Read **Romans 6:4**. What does it mean for you to "walk in newness of life." Consider the various phases of your journey—searching, grinding, carrying, finishing. Which phase best describes where you are today? What difference does the truth of the resurrection make for you in this stage?
